RESTORE CLEANING THINNERS

1. DESCRIPTION

Restore Cleaning Thinners is a powerful solvent based cleaner which is water rinse-able

3. FEATURES

- For cleaning of paintbrushes and rollers
- General cleaning and degreasing of garage floors and driveway paving
- Ideal for cleaning oils and grime build in kitchens, baths, ceramic tile areas, drains, etc
- Restore Cleaning Thinners is recommended for the removal of tar and waxes from floors, car bodies, etc.
- An effective cleaner for removing dirt and paint spots on most clothing fabric and carpets
- Suitable for degreasing other cold surfaces such as car engines, factory machinery and agricultural equipment.
- A powerful solvent based cleaner that can be easily rinsed with water...

4. APPLICATION

- For cleaning brushes and rollers: Pour a small amount of Restore Cleaning Thinners into a suitable clean container. Work it thoroughly into the brush or roller. Then rinse brush or roller well with water until water is no longer milky. Hang brush or roller up to dry. Allow the mixture remaining in the container to separate. The clear top layer may be re-used. If the enamel has dried completely on the brush, it should first be soaked in Restore Paint Stripper, allowing the paint to soften and blister and then further cleaned with Restore Cleaning Thinners.
- For heavy duty degreaser (e.g. uncoated garage floors and drive-ways): Swab Restore Cleaning Thinners onto the soiled areas
 using a bristle brush or broom and work the solution well into the surface. Leave for approximately 15 minutes then flush off thoroughly
 with water while scrubbing with the brush or broom. Heavy deposits and deeply penetrated oil stains may require repeated applications.
 In such cases allow surface to dry before re-applying Restore Cleaning Thinners
- Areas to be painted: Ensure that a water break-free surface is attained and rinse thoroughly until the water wash is clean and no longer milky.
- For clothing fabric and carpets: swab Restore Cleaning Thinners liberally onto the soiled area using a cloth or sponge, dabbing and
 rubbing gently. Apply until the soil mark has disappeared. Apply clean water in a similar way until all the Restore Cleaning Thinners
 has been washed out of the fabric. Rub dry gently.

5. LIMITATION

- Do not use plastic, painted areas and other surfaces that may be attacked by solvents. If unsure apply Restore Cleaning Thinners in an inconspicuous spot to check if substrate is attacked.
- After use always ensure that all traces of Restore Cleaning Thinners are rinsed off.
- When cleaning fabric Restore Cleaning Thinners will not damage the fabric. Do not keep the product in contact with the fabric for longer than absolutely necessary.
- If using Restore Cleaning Thinners to degrease an engine, note that it may remove grease from bearings and soften plastic parts
