1.DESCRIPTION

Impa School Board Paint is a high quality ultra-durable water based paint with unique surface properties.

2. FEATURES

- Extremely washable.
- Easy application through use of brush, roller or spray gun and dries quickly; two coats can be applied in a one day.
- Through its high pigmentation it has exceptional coating capacity, which results in savings on labour and material.
- The product is water-based, therefore cleaning of equipment performed at low coast.
- Dries quickly to an extremely durable finish
- Provides excellent chalk removal via a duster leaving no chalk writing behind.
- No marks are left behind after chalk removal
- Duster wear is minimal
- The relatively smooth surface provides for easy wiping off of the chalk.
- Excellent flow and leveling properties

3. SUBSTRATE CONDITIONS

Substrate must be clean, dry and sound for painting. **Moisture content** must be **below 14% WME**, measured using a PROTIMETER (or equally approved).

4. SURFACE PREPARATIONS

N.B. For good results sand lightly between coats to ensure optimum smoothness.

- NEW WORK
 - Hardboard & MDF Board:

Prime with Impa Hydroprime Plaster Primer

- Wood:
 - Prime with Impa Pink Wood Primer
- Mild Steel:

Degrease with Restore Heavy Duty Degreaser and rinse thoroughly with clean water. Remove any rust by coarse sanding, mechanical grinding or with Restore Rust Convertor. Prime with Impa Zinc Phosphate Primer

PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES IN GOOD

CONDITION

Remove any loose and flaking paint, clean and spot prime with the appropriate primer. Clean paintwork with Restore Sugar Soap solution and rinse thoroughly. Sand glossy enamel areas to a matt finish.

PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES IN POOR CONDITION Strip completely and proceed as for new work.

5. APPLICATION

Apply two coats of IMPA SCHOOL BOARD PAINT allowing 4 hours drying time between coats.

6. PRECAUTIONS

- Application should be avoided in cold and moist weather conditions.
- Do Not apply the product at surface temperatures below 6°C (minimum of 2°C above dew point) and temperatures above 40°C
- Do Not apply if ambient temperature is less than 10°C or more than 40°C.
- Do Not apply if relative humidity temperature is less than 10°C or more than 85. °C
- Pay attention to the preparation of surfaces
- Preferable not for direct application to new surfaces.
- To ensure that colour on a project are consistent, check that batch numbers are the same. Should the batches numbers differ please "box" the paint box the paint before using it
- Friable and powdery surfaces require special care before painting- if in doubt contact Impa Advisory Service
